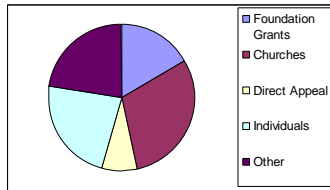
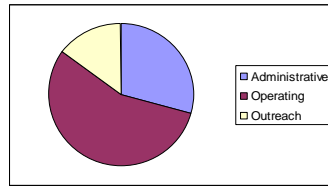

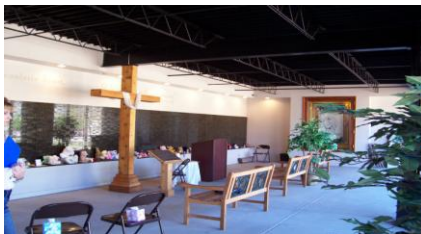
What a mighty God we serve!
